

## 28<sup>th</sup> Brazilian Independence Day Festival in Boston

The 7 de Setembro Organizing Committee and the Brazilian Women's Group are delighted to invite you to the **28**<sup>th</sup> **Brazilian Independence Day Festival**, which will take place on **Sunday**, **September 10**<sup>th</sup>, **2023**, from **1 PM to 5 PM at the DCR Herter Park** (1175 Soldiers Field Road), located in Brighton, MA.

For 28 years, the **Brazilian Independence Day Festival** has been an annual highlight of the community. It is the largest Brazilian cultural event in New England, attracting crowds of over 7,000 people. This is an ideal opportunity to promote your business and your food to the Brazilian community. As in previous years, the 2023 Festival will feature children's activities, information tables, arts and crafts, ethnic food, live Brazilian music, and many other attractions. All the events are free and wheelchair accessible.

The cost of having a food table, including fees for inspection and licenses required, are the following:

One table cost: \$50.00 Food license: \$30.00 Inspection fee: \$25.00

\*Total cost for one food table: \$105.00

\*However, if you are going to cook in the park, you must also pay an additional \$150 (one hundred fifty dollars) for the propane license. In this case, your final total for one table will be \$255.00.

Each table rental includes one (1) table, one (1) tablecloth, and two (2) chairs. Any other objects/equipment require prior authorization from the Organizing Committee. Vendors may **not** use their own tables to display products for sale at the event.

Any food or drink prepared off-site must be prepared in a kitchen that has a Health Permit provided by the local city. You must provide proof of the Health Permit to participate in the festival.

All vendors must attend the Food Meeting on Monday, August 14th, 2023, from 6 PM to 8 PM, at the
