General duties and responsibilities

- Provide group instruction to adults enrolled in ESOL classes.
- Develop lesson plans and resources using a participatory, learner-centered approach.
- Assess students regularly, including in-class quizzes and formal assessment tests, evaluations, notes on students' progress towards goals, and other relevant materials.
- Maintain comprehensive files tracking student needs, interest and progress.
- Incorporate appropriate technology into curriculum and instructional methods.
- Assist with program recruitment and intake activities as necessary
- Participate in coordinating meetings & support
- Class times are during the day, two times a week, three hours per class and one weekly conversational class

Desired qualifications

- Previous ESOL teaching experience with adults *very important*, especially with low-income women; bachelor's degree in education or related helpful
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Experience and ability to work with individuals of diverse cultural, linguistic and socioeconomic backgrounds
- Commitment to social justice
- Bilingual very helpful, but not necessary
